## National higher educational scholarship Scoring of non-scientific, public, sport, and other activities

(Compiled by the Student Union of ELTE Faculty of Science (ELTE TTK HÖK))

The maximum score is 50 points. The certification of each activity is necessary; without an official certification of participation, no points can be awarded. It is a priority that the public activity should primarily serve the students of the Faculty of Science. Volunteering for charities is also considered. Given the proper certification, sports and other activities (organization, presentation) can be accepted as well.

The committee has the right to score activities individually in case they cannot be fitted into the above categories.

If the applicant won the national higher educational scholarship (or formerly the Republic of Hungary Scholarship) in a previous year, only the achievements since the previous application will be considered in the new application round.

Points are only awarded if the activity or achievement is appropriately documented with an official certification. Certification from the president of the organization responsible for the public activity is accepted. If the president is the applicant, the secretary of the organization has to issue the certification. In the case of sports, the copy of the original award certificate or an official document issued by the president of the sports organization can be accepted.

Besides activities connected to the Student Union (ELTE TTK HÖK), certification of tutoring (besides its coordinator's), participation in the above-mentioned publicity events, or being a delegate in the Master's entrance examination committee can be issued by the president of the Student Union upon request submitted by the student to the vice president of the Student Union. Requests have to be sent electronically to <u>elnokhelyettes@ttkhok.elte.hu</u>. You have to include the event/activity for which you request the certification and your Neptun ID, and you must put "közéleti igazolás" (certification of public activity) in the subject field.
